Jefferson County 4-H Council Meeting Minutes

June 23, 2025

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Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by President Abraham Noll. Flag salute, 4-H Pledge, and 4-H motto were recited.

Eight clubs answered roll call.

Minutes from the May 27, 2025, meeting were approved as emailed.

Reports

The treasurer's report indicated total funds available to the council were \$51,681.68 as of June 18.

As an addition to the treasurer's report, the Council discussed getting the most value out of the Council's CDs. It was approved to transfer the full \$10,000 amount from the Denison State Bank CD to a CD at Union State Bank in Oskaloosa.

Fair Board President Jason Roenne provided a report. He discussed the vendor application process, sharing that all vendor applications must be submitted and approved for individuals or businesses planning to set up at the fair. New vendor types, such as bounce houses, are being allowed this year. Interested parties must go through the fair board's application process. It was also reported that any 4-H project exceeding 3 feet in any direction must receive prior approval due to space constraints.

In Roenne's building update, he reported that the Horticulture Building will temporarily house poultry and rabbit projects due to renovations. Ongoing renovations include excavation near the poultry/rabbit and sheep barns and installation of new doors and a ceiling in the north restroom.

Unfinished Business

Under Unfinished Business, the group was notified about the availability of fair schedule posters to display in communities, and the new senior banners were placed on display.

It was also reported that 4-H Fair T-Shirts were available in limited supply.

All 4-H members were urged to attend Fair set-up on July 26.

President Abe Noll adjourned the meeting at 8:25 p.m.
