

**APPLICATION FOR JEFFERSON COUNTY EDUCATIONAL EXTENSION UNIT (JCEEU)**

1. Applicants are to be a Jefferson County resident and high school senior or college freshman and plan to attend an in-state institution. They do not need to be a 4-H member to apply.

Jefferson County Educational Extension Units Scholarship(s) (JCEEU)

*Note: **Applicants MUST attend an in-state institution.***

2. **Application, transcript of grades, essay and letters of recommendation must be submitted by Friday, April 1, 2026, to Meadowlark District Extension Office, 100 E Washington St, PO Box 326, Oskaloosa, Kansas, 66066. Office hours are 8:00am to 4:30pm. No late applications or recommendations will be accepted.**
3. Candidate should have a grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. (Verified by a school administrator).
4. Submit **2** letters of recommendation – 1 from school administrator or teacher  
1 from 4-H club leader, religious leader, employer, etc.

*Note: When asking for letters of recommendation, have them directly given to you. (They may be in a sealed envelope if they so choose). Many times, the person giving the recommendation will mail to us, but then they forget. By you getting the recommendation directly you know that the letter was done and ready to submit on time. (We will not follow up for any recommendations.)*

5. List activities and achievements in 4-H, Scouts, FFA, FCCLA, college, as well as participation in athletics, dramatics, art, church groups, etc. **Please record your school activities and involvement in activities on the form provided with this application. Do not attach additional pages or summaries.**
6. Each applicant is asked to submit an essay – 1 page, 1 side, double spaced, no less than 12 pt. font, stating “Why you are deserving of this scholarship”. **There will be no interviews conducted.**
7. Each winner must use scholarship fund starting with the fall term.
  - a. First ½ of scholarship will be given after enrollment of the first semester and proof of enrollment sent to the Extension Office. **(Checks will be sent in August after proof of enrollment is sent)**
  - b. **Second ½ of scholarship will be sent when the recipient furnishes proof of passing grades** (may be university’s computer-generated grades) at end of 1<sup>st</sup> semester and re-enrollment to the Extension Office. (No reminders will be sent out to students for the information.)
  - c. No student will be able to receive this scholarship more than 2 years in a row.
